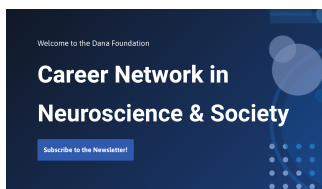
Introducing the Career Network in Neuroscience & Society
